

Ordinary Time

Liturgical Calendar May 20 - November 30

The first half of the Church calendar, ranging from Advent to Pentecost, is devoted to tracing the grand arc of God's saving action in Jesus Christ. The second half of the Church calendar is a long stretch called Ordinary Time. It starts the day after Pentecost Sunday and leads right up to the first Sunday in Advent, meaning that most of the year is spent here!

With all the big holidays and celebrations over, Ordinary Time offers us the space to find our place in God's story. We've celebrated and taken in the momentous life of Jesus; now we need a long stretch of days to absorb and assimilate it. In Ordinary Time, we fully take in the gospel and allow it to take shape in our daily living – making connections between Jesus' story and ours.

"Ordinary" doesn't mean boring or secondrate but simply "every day." The Christian faith is not an otherworldly faith; it's about this creation, your life, these days. Ordinary Time gives us the space to consider what it means to follow Jesus as those who've received his salvation, in our day-by-day, week-in, week-out, everyday, ordinary lives.
